



## **Safety Officer**

The safety officer will be part of the OCI team to further enhance the company's safety culture. The incumbent will continuously strive to make improvements with OCI's safety management systems across their six Offshore Factory Freezer vessels as well as their onshore facilities. The successful incumbent will be a key driver in ensuring that safe and efficient operational requirements are met, traceability and audits of current SMS programs are completed as well as proactive scheduling and training for staff. Details of the position and qualifications required follows:

### **Responsibilities;**

- Closely co-operating with the vessel and plant managers on day-to-day matters to ensure an uninterrupted Safe & Secure operation of the vessels and plants.
- Carry out safety audits, risk assessments and incident investigations for all operations
- Keep up to date with all new legislation and maintain a working knowledge of all Health & Safety legislation across all operations by informing colleagues accordingly
- Promote a culture of continuous Health and safety improvement and ensure best practice across the company.
- Maintaining and keeping the SMS/ security documentation and records up-to date and organised;
- Assist in WHSCC claim management, safe and early return to work, and modified work programs for injured or ill employees
- Liaison with 3rd party consultants and/or the OHS Provincial Division regarding occupational Health & Safety development and progression.

### **Requirements**

- Certification in one or more of the following – Certificate in Occupational Health & Safety, Certificate in Environmental Management through a recognized Community College; or University degree in Industrial Hygiene, Environmental Engineering, Environmental Sciences
- 1 to 3 years of environmental, health, safety and security work experience preferably with offshore Factory Freezer Trawlers.
- Strong Understanding of Provincial OHS, ISM, environmental, health and safety regulatory requirements
- Strong organizational and communication skills.
- Marine Emergency Duties certification and valid Marine Medical would be assets
- Familiarization with the Maritime Occupational Health and Safety Regulations (MOSH) and International Safety Management Code (ISM), would be an asset.
