Responsibilities:

Reporting to the Plant Manager, the Procurement/Wharf Manager will perform their duties with a high degree of efficiency and accuracy, and will be responsible for, but not limited to the following:

- Oversee the landing, offloading and transporting of raw material at 8 offloading sites around the Burin Peninsula.
- Coordinating trucks to deliver ice and bait to these landing sites.
- Oversee all offloading at the plant wharf.
- Coordinating workers to offload fishing vessels when they arrive.
- Fishing vessel scheduling for when fishing vessels are leaving and returning.
- Daily reports to identify how much raw material went to the plant for processing.
- Completing all paperwork for all raw material and other supplies to and from the plant.
- Other duties as they arise.

Effective communication skills are essential as you will be in contact with fishers, plant employees and managers daily. The successful candidate, through experience and education, will need to demonstrate sound judgment, problem solving skills and the capability to manage multiple projects in a demanding, fast-paced work environment.

Experience with the use of computer applications (Excel, Word, Outlook, etc.) would be beneficial.

This is a full-time, seasonal position, typically from April to October of each year. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
