Key Responsibilities

- Perform electrical maintenance, troubleshooting, and repairs on processing equipment, refrigeration systems, conveyors, packaging lines, and plant utilities.
- Diagnose and respond to equipment breakdowns in a timely manner to minimize production interruptions.
- Carry out preventive and predictive maintenance programs on electrical and mechanical systems.
- Install, test, and maintain electrical wiring, controls, motors, PLCs, sensors, and panels in accordance with applicable codes and standards.
- Assist with general plant maintenance tasks, including mechanical repairs.
- Support commissioning of new equipment and plant upgrades.
- Maintain accurate maintenance logs, work orders, and parts usage records.
- Ensure compliance with workplace health and safety regulations, lockout/tagout procedures, and food safety requirements.
- Maintain tools, workshop areas, and spare parts inventory in a clean and organized manner.
- Work closely with production teams to prioritize maintenance needs and support operational goals.
- Be available for shift work, overtime, and on-call response during peak production periods.

Qualifications and Experience

- Industrial Electrician certification (or equivalent) preferred.
- Previous experience in an industrial or food processing environment, preferably seafood processing, considered an asset.
- Strong knowledge of industrial electrical systems, motors, controls, and automation.
- Other general maintenance as assigned by the management team
