### Procurement Wharf Manager, St. Lawrence

#### Responsibilities

Reporting to the Plant Manager, the Procurement Wharf Manager will perform their duties with a high degree of efficiency and accuracy, and will be responsible for, but not limited to, the following:

- Oversee the landing, offloading, and transportation of raw materials at eight offloading sites around the Burin Peninsula.
- Coordinate trucks to deliver ice and bait to the landing sites.
- Supervise all offloading at the plant wharf and coordinate workers to offload fishing vessels upon arrival.
- Schedule fishing vessels for departures and returns.
- Prepare daily reports to track the quantity of raw materials delivered to the plant for processing.
- Complete all paperwork for raw materials and other supplies to and from the plant.
- Perform other duties as required.

#### Qualifications & Experience

- Effective communication skills, as you will be in contact with harvesters, plant employees, and managers.
- Demonstrated sound judgment and problem-solving skills through education and experience.
- Ability to manage multiple projects in a demanding, fast-paced work environment.
- Experience with computer applications such as Excel, Word, Outlook, etc., is beneficial.
