The Assistant Treasurer will be responsible for cash management, budgeting, financial planning and analysis, and risk management and insurance.

Key Responsibilities:

- Support oversight of international cash management account structures and bank providers.
- Manage daily corporate liquidity and execute funds transfers, ensuring strong internal controls and treasury governance.
- Coordinate short-term borrowing activity and communication with banks.
- Prepare consolidated cash and liquidity forecasts.
- Establish and maintain relationships with commercial bankers, ensuring timely reporting and communication.
- Support debt reporting compliance requirements.
- Liaise with accounts payable, sales, and procurement teams to obtain timely cash flow information that supports decision-making.
- Support hedging program including FX, interest rate, and commodity market exposures, analysis, execution, reporting, and controls.
- Prepare working capital management reporting and analysis to support decision-making.
- Participate in key treasury initiatives, such as optimizing capital structure through financing; and implement systems and process improvements to enhance treasury operations.
- Support budgets, forecasts and financial planning and analysis.
- Maintain account continuity schedules, reconciliations and scheduled journal entries and reporting.

- Liaise with insurance brokers and underwriters to ensure the business maintains appropriate insurance coverage across operations.
- Prepare ad hoc financial analysis.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 5 years of experience in finance and treasury operations with progressive responsibility and team management.
- Bachelor's degree in finance, accounting or a related field; CPA or CFA is an asset.
