Third Engineer, Offshore Factory Freezer Vessel

Ocean Choice is currently accepting applications for the position of **Third Engineer** aboard one of our offshore factory freezer vessels. This is a full-time, permanent trip-on/trip-off position reporting to the Chief Engineer. The Third Engineer supports the safe and efficient operation of the vessel's engineering systems through the maintenance, troubleshooting, and repair of propulsion systems, auxiliary machinery, and related equipment while ensuring compliance with company policies, safety standards, and marine regulations.

The successful candidate will work closely with the engineering team and vessel crew to support safe, reliable, and efficient vessel operations at sea.

Responsibilities

- Assist the Chief and 2nd Engineers with vessel operations and complete delegated engineering and technical tasks.
- Operate and maintain main propulsion systems, auxiliary engines, and auxiliary equipment, including pumps, compressors, generators, and hydraulic systems.
- Perform scheduled preventative maintenance, including lubricating, cleaning, inspecting, and replacing worn components to ensure optimal equipment performance.
- Troubleshoot and repair mechanical and electrical equipment failures to minimize downtime and support safe vessel operations.
- Stand engine room watch in accordance with vessel schedules while monitoring engine performance, fuel consumption, alarms, and operating systems.
- Respond promptly to alarms, abnormalities, and equipment breakdowns by taking appropriate corrective action.
- Maintain accurate records of engine performance, maintenance activities, and spare parts inventory.
- Ensure compliance with company policies, marine regulations, and vessel safety procedures.
- Support environmental protection initiatives, including pollution prevention and waste management practices.

- Maintain firefighting and emergency response equipment and actively participate in emergency drills and safety exercises.
- Work closely with deck crew and engineering personnel to coordinate repairs and support efficient vessel operations.
- Communicate clearly and professionally with the Chief Engineer and senior officers regarding equipment condition, maintenance requirements, and operational issues.
